PATH TO A FRESH START & CLEAR CONSCIENCE

1. REVIEW _____

Let us test and examine our ways. Lam. 3:40a (NLT)

Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there. Gal. 5:24 (NLT)

Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives. Gal. 5:25 (NLT)

2. REPENT _____

Let us turn again in repentance to the Lord. Let us lift our hearts and hands to God in heaven and say, "We have sinned and rebelled." Lam. 3:40b-42a (NLT)

So turn to God! Give up your sins, and you will be forgiven. Acts 3:19 (CEV)

3. RESOLVE _____

"If I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount." Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to your house." Luke 19:8-9

4. RECEIVE _____

Let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it. Heb. 4:16 (NLT)

Since we are justified (acquitted and declared righteous) through faith, let us grasp the fact that we now have peace and reconciliation with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Rom. 5:1 (Amp)

5. REVEAL _____

Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. James 5:16a

6. REPEAT _____

Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience. Heb. 10:22

Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. Heb. 10:23
