HOW THE LORD BECAME "MY SHEPHERD"

1. JESUS DIED _____

All of us were like sheep that were lost, each of us going his own way. But the Lord made the punishment fall on him, the punishment all of us deserved. Isaiah 53:6 (GN)

2. JESUS MADE ME _____

The sacrificed Jesus made us fit for God, set us right with God. Rom. 4:25 (Mes)

God... raised our Lord Jesus Christ from death. Now Jesus is like a Great Shepherd whose blood was used to make God's eternal agreement with his flock. Heb. 13:20

3. JESUS OFFERED ME _____

This is what the Lord God says: "I, myself, will search for my sheep and take care of them." Eze. 34:11 (NCV)

Then Jesus said to his followers, "If people want to follow me, they must give up the things they want. They must be willing even to give up their lives to follow me."

Matt. 16:24 (NCV)

4. I DECIDED _____

Christ carried the burden of our sins... Now you have returned to the one who is your shepherd and protector.
