WHY ONLY JESUS CAN CHANGE MY HEART

1. JESUS TOOK MY _____

God sent Christ Jesus to take the punishment for our sins and to end all God's anger against us. Rom. 3:25

God took the sinless Christ and poured into him our sins. Then, in exchange, He poured God's goodness into us! 2 Cor. 5:21

2. JESUS BOUGHT MY _____

He gave His life to purchase freedom for everyone. 1 Tim. 2:6a (NLT)

3. JESUS MADE ME _____

Christ changed us from enemies into His friends and gave us the task of making others His friends also. Our message is that God is making all human beings His friends through Christ. God did not keep an account of their sins, and He has given us the message which tells how He makes them His friends. 2 Cor. 5:18-19 (GN)

4. JESUS GAVE ME _____

God saved us because of His mercy... He washed us by the power of the Holy Spirit. He gave us new birth and a fresh beginning. Titus 3:5 (CEV)

Anyone who belongs to Christ becomes a new person. The past is forgotten, and everything is new. 2 Cor. 5:17

5. JESUS DEFEATED _____
